King Eiders live in the high Arctic. They are known to nest on the edge of sea ice. They are vulnerable to climate change. King Eiders are black and white with a red-orange bill and blue head. They forage mainly underwater and can dive more than 150 feet. They enjoy feeding on shellfish. King Eiders migrate in large groups and can fly up to 40 miles per hour. Observers in northern Alaska counted 360,000 migrating in 10 hours. They migrate mostly over frozen seas.
