Palm Warblers are brownish-green with yellow underparts and have a red head. They can usually be found on the ground. They can be recognized by how they bob their tail up and down. Palm Warblers are an eastern migratory bird, which can be seen in Canada. Their population is steady with no risk of being endangered. They make their homes in low trees, bushes, and on the ground. Palm Warblers do not act like a warbler, as they like to walk on the ground finding insects and fruit to eat. They also eat mosquitoes, flies, small beetles, ants, and spiders. Palm Warblers lay 4 to 5 eggs at a time. They migrate early in the spring and late in the fall.
